1 Workshop Venue

Location. All talks except on November 14 will take place at Amphithéâtre Alan Turing at the [Sophie Germain Building](#) of [Université Paris Cité](#). The street address is 8, Place Aurélie Nemours, 75013 Paris.

The talks on Thursday November 14 will take place at Amphithéâtre Pierre-Gilles de Gennes, at the [Condorcet Building](#). The street address is 4 Rue Elsa Morante, 75013 Paris.

Talks. To connect your laptop for your talk, an HDMI connection is provided. If you need an adaptor, please approach the organizers in advance. Do try to check your connection and slides well ahead of your talk.

The local clientele usually eats at around 1PM, and restaurants and brasseries are typically packed at this time. In order to get a table in a restaurant, it would be advisable to make sure to be seated before 1PM.
