## 1 Workshop Venue

All talks will take place at [Amphithéâtre Vulpian](#) at the Odéon Campus of [Université Paris Cité](#). The street address is 12, rue de l'école de médecine.

To connect your laptop for your talk, an HDMI connection is provided. If you need an adaptor, please approach the organizers in advance. Do try to check your connection and slides before your talk.

### Coffee.

*10 Belles*, 53 rue du Cherche Midi (15 minutes ) - great coffee and also very good bread and baked items.

*Café Louisa* 54 Rue Saint-Placide (20 minutes)

*Cafe du clown* 6 Rue Lobineau (Marché Saint Germain, 5 minutes)

### Pastries.

*Pâtisserie Mulot*, 76 Rue de Seine

*Arnaud Larher*, 93 Rue de Seine (5 minutes)

*Pierre Hermé*, 72 Rue Bonaparte (10 minutes)

Many excellent places to try on rue du Bac

Favorite is *Conticini* 37 Rue de Varenne(20 minutes)

### Traditional French (lunch or dinner).

Many restaurants on rue du cherche-midi are very good

*Le Nemrod* 51 Rue du Cherche-Midi is a good classic brasserie

Classic Steak Frites (only) - Relais de l'Entrecôte, there is one at 20, rue Saint-Benoît.

Classic Moules Frite (mostly) - Léon de Bruxelles, there is one at 131 Bd Saint-Germain

*Le Bon Saint Pour cain*, 10bis Rue Servandoni )(much fancier)

*Polidor*, 41 rue Monsieur Le Prince.

*Le bar des prés* 25 Rue du Dragon (For a special occasion, expensive but worth it)

**Asian.**

*Kodawari* 29 Rue Mazarine, for Ramen and decor

*Jixiao's buns*, 21 Quai des Grands Augustins, personal favorite, go for the dry spicy noodles + dumplings.

**breakfast/lunch/café**

*grab a sandwich* anywhere, and head for the *Luxembourg gardens*

*patisserie Viennoise*, 8 Rue de l'École de Médecine

*Yabai Sando*, 3-5 Rue des Quatre Vents, Japanese sandwiches

*Sôma Sando*, Japanese sandwiches 62 Rue de Vaugirard (10 minutes)

*Café Maa*, 33 Rue du Sommerard.

*Le tram librairie café* 7 Rue de la Montagne Sainte Geneviève, (10 minutes)

*Breizh cafe*, 1 Rue de l'Odéon, Crêpes (many more crêpe options on rue Montparnasse - not to be confused with Avenue Montparnasse which is close by)

*Le cercle Luxembourg*, 1 Rue Gay-Lussac. Great Tarte Tatin (when available)

*Au petit suisse* 16 Rue de Vaugirard, French style cafe that hasn't changed in decades.

**On at Opera de Paris:**

*Opera:* Ariodante and La Bohème set in space

*Ballet:* Dante project and Bejart
